## 2025 THLA HOTEL SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION: KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

#### What to Pack:

Students are requested to dress in business casual attire throughout their participation in hotel summer camp activities. Business casual attire may consist of khaki pants/skirts or jeans (free from fraying or holes) paired with a collared shirt or women's blouse. As hotel conference rooms tend to be cool, students are advised to bring a light sweater or jacket. Some camp activities involve short walks, so it is important to have comfortable walking shoes. Additionally, suggested items to pack include:

- 2 sets of business casual outfits, aside from the one worn on Tuesday
- Swimsuit, cover-up, and pool shoes
- Comfortable shoes suitable for tours; flip flops are not recommended
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Pajamas/sleepwear
- 2 conservative, casual outfits for optional evening free time
- Medical insurance card or a copy of both sides of the card
- Cash for incidentals such as soft drinks or snacks throughout the camp Items available in the hotel room:
  - Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, and soap)
  - Blow dryer

## **Arrival and Parking:**

There is ample parking for normal size passenger vehicles in the hotel parking garages. Please notify Debbie Wieland in advance of the camp if you plan to arrive in a school bus or require school bus parking.

Upon arrival, please report to the hotel lobby for directions to the THLA High School Hotel Summer Camp check-in table for camp materials and nametags. A secure storage area will be provided for participant luggage until the scheduled room check-in time.

The camp will begin promptly at 10:00 AM so please plan to arrive by 9:30 AM to park and check in for the camp before 10:00 AM. Please note that breakfast is not provided on the first day of summer camp.
